## Why?

A five-member Tranquility envoy will travel to Kenya in October 2009, where they will train and teach Kenyan stylists at Coco T's Hair Affair Salon in Kawangware, Kenya. The goal is to encourage financial stability and self-sufficiency while sharing the word of God. During the 10-day trip, Tranquility's team will train the Kenyan stylists in hair color, hair relaxer treatments and business principles. We will also be training young women to become stylists.

*"Tranquility is honored to be part of this spiritual and educational opportunity to help uplift and transform the quality of life for so many of our fellow Kenyan stylists who are looking to become more self-sufficient,"* said Cyndi Welch, Tranquility Day Spa & Salon hairstylist and team leader of the Tranquility/Kenyan trip. *"By forging a new way, we're hoping to encourage and inspire other salons in the U.S. to donate their time and services to help stylists around the world that are in need of supplies and additional training to better their lives,"* said Welch.



## Additional Information

Many of the young women in the Kawangware area, where the unemployment rate is more than 60 percent, are forced to do menial jobs for menial sums to help pay the rent on their parent's house. By having a marketable trade many of them can set up their own salons. Tranquility will give training certificates to those who qualify which can be a starting place for their business portfolio and hopefully will provide employment opportunities for them in the future.

All additional donations will go toward The Hope Center, an organization based in Nairobi, Kenya. Since 2002, The Hope Center has assisted in the educational, physical and spiritual needs of the community. The eight-acre campus features a church, a school for pre-k through junior high school students, a sports program and various humanitarian help groups. Free HIV/AIDS support groups and yearly medical clinics are also offered to the public. In addition, it is the home of Vapor Sports ([www.vaporsports.org](http://www.vaporsports.org)), where soccer teams and training is offered.
